Required Fiscal Year 2024 Appropriation: \$166,512,936

This Commission is hereby furnishing you with the amount to be appropriated for your retirement system for Fiscal Year 2024 which commences July 1, 2023.

As we indicated in PERAC Memo #26/2022, we are no longer including the Projected Appropriations page as an attachment. Attached please find the portion of the Fiscal Year 2024 appropriation to be paid by each of the governmental units within your system. The allocation by governmental unit was developed by Segal Consulting as part of their January 1, 2022 actuarial valuation.

If your System has a valuation currently in progress, you may submit a revised funding schedule to PERAC upon its completion. The current schedule is due to be updated by Fiscal Year 2025.
