DECISION

JONSIN LLC D/B/A COUNTRYSIDE LIQUORS 170 CENTRAL STREET MILFORD, MA 01757 LICENSE#: 00045-PK-0706

VIOLATION DATE: 12/08/2023

HEARD: 3/19/2024

Jonsin LLC d/b/a Countryside Liquors ("Licensee" or "Countryside Liquors") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("ABCC" or "Commission") held a remote hearing via Microsoft Teams on Tuesday, March 19, 2024, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age (1 count). Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigator Quinn's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Investigator Quinn's Report;
- 2. Photograph of Fraudulent Identification Utilized;
- 3. ABCC Form 43, License Transfer of License Approval, 5/14/2004;
- 4. Licensee Stipulation of Facts.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. On Friday, December 8, 2023, Investigators Keefe and Quinn ("Investigators"), conducted observations of Jonsin LLC d/b/a Countryside Liquors ("Licensee" or "Countryside Liquors") to determine the way its business was being conducted.
- 2. At approximately 7:00 p.m., Investigators observed a youthful appearing individual enter the licensed premises and shortly thereafter exit the establishment in possession of alcoholic beverages: one 1.75-liter bottle of Amsterdam vodka, one 750-ml bottle of Tito's vodka, one 10-pack sleeve of Dr. McGillicuddy's Mentholmint liqueur, and one 18-pack of Coors Light beer.
- 3. Investigators identified themselves and asked to see proof of legal age to purchase and/or possess alcoholic beverages.

- 4. Underage #1, actual date of birth 6/09/2004 (age 19), provided to Investigators a fraudulent Rhode Island driver's license bearing his name but a different birth date which he used to purchase the alcoholic beverages.
- 5. At approximately 7:50 p.m. Investigators entered the licensed premises and spoke with an employee, informed her of the violation and that a report would be filed with the Chief Investigator for review.
- 6. The Licensee has held a license under M.G.L. c. 138, § 15 since 2004 with no prior violations.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 34 Sale or Delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age (1 count). Therefore, the Commission suspends the license for a period of one (1) day which will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided that no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations are found by this Commission.
