Daniel P. Spring dba JT's Corner Store (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, October 30, 2012, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch.138 §34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age, according to Investigator Keefe's Compliance Check Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Investigator Keefe's Compliance Check Field Report dated May 21, 2012; and
- 2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

FACTS

- 1. On Monday, May 21, 2012, at approximately 6:54 p.m., Investigators Kujawski and Keefe conducted an investigation of the business operation of Daniel P. Spring dba JT's Corner Store.
- 2. An underage operative working with investigators purchased an alcoholic beverage, a twenty-four ounce (24 oz.) can of Budweiser Light beer for two dollars and forty cents (\$2.40). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch.138 §34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one years of age. Therefore, the Commission suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of one (1) year provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
