## DECISION

HIGHLAND WINE & SPIRITS CO. DBA LUMPY'S LIQUORS 40 EXCHANGE STREET **MILLIS, MA 02054** LICENSE #: 071600012 HEARD: 3/6/2012

Highland Wine & Spirits Co. dba Lumpy's Liquors (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, March 6, 2012, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c.138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Jan Kujawski's Compliance Check Field Report.


## **FACTS**

- 1. On, September 14, 2011 at approximately 6:36 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation of Highland Wine & Spirits Co. dba Lumpy's Liquors.
- 2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a Coors Light beer can for two dollars (\$2.00). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

## CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated Massachusetts General Laws c. 138, §34. The Commission suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.
