Millis Pkg Store Corp dba Harkeys (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, §15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, July 31, 2012, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05(2), to wit: c.138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Carey's Compliance Check Field Report.

- 2. An underage operative working with investigators purchased an alcoholic beverage, a sixteen ounce (16 oz.) can of Bud Lite beer for one dollar and sixty-five cents (\$1.65). The underage operative was not asked for identification.
