


Milton Route 28 Road Diet Pilot

Abutter Impacts



What is happening?

MassDOT is conducting a Road Diet Pilot on **Route 28 (Randolph Avenue) from Reedsdale Road to Chickatawbut Road in Milton**. The goal of the Pilot is to address ongoing public safety concerns along the corridor by reducing speeds and conflicts. Pilot programs use temporary materials to test out potential roadway changes. Drivers may experience temporary disruptions during the initial installation, but no major construction activities will occur beyond this period. Once the Pilot is complete, MassDOT will evaluate the results using pre- and post-Pilot data collection and feedback to determine the next steps.

How will I be impacted?

The Pilot will reduce Route 28 from four travel lanes to two travel lanes, introduce two-way left-turn lanes in areas of dense access, and install painted medians with flexible delineation posts on raised curbing in areas where left turns will be restricted. Each block along Route 28 has a design tailored to what is most appropriate for that location.



Abutter Impacts

Abutter Impacts: Drivers should expect an adjustment period to the Road Diet Pilot. Drivers can expect the following conditions:

- Reedsdale Road to Milton Department of Public Works (DPW): Painted median preventing left turns.
*AccentCare Inpatient Hospice Center: Left turns allowed in and out of facility driveway.
- Route 28 Northbound U-turns allowed for passenger vehicles at Reedsdale Road.
*Trucks should reroute via Reedsdale Road and Centre Street
- Milton DPW to Pleasant Street: Two-way left-turn lane.
- Pleasant Street to Reed Street: Restricted left turns with flexposts.
- Route 28 southbound U-turns allowed for passenger vehicles at Reed Street.
- Reed Street to Ridgewood Road: Restricted left turns with flexposts.
- Route 28 southbound U-turns allowed for passenger vehicles at Ridgewood Road. Route 28 northbound vehicles impacted by restrictions can turn left onto Reed Street and utilize local roadway network for re-routing.
- Ridgewood Road to Hilltop Street: Two-way left-turn lane.
- South of Hilltop Street to North of Hillside Street: Restricted left turns with flexposts. Left turns allowed to/from Hilltop Street and Hillside Street.
- Hillside Street to Chickatawbut Road: Two-way left turn lanes.
