1. Meeting called to order by the Chairman, Ed Kawa, at 10:20 A.M. The Chairman opened this meeting of the Board of Boiler Rules, and explained that the Board will be conducting a regular meeting of the Board in accordance with M.G.L. Chapter 146 §3.

3. Minutes from previous meeting: The minutes from the previous meeting held on November 1, 2018, were reviewed. ***Motion to approve the minutes made by Anthony Lucia, seconded by Charlie Perry; motion passed by unanimous vote.***

4. Petitions for inspectional considerations: The following requests for extension of the inspectional requirement were entered into record:
- a. Wheelabrator North Andover, request dated November 5, 2018, for a 6-month extension of the inspectional requirement for MAS064279.
  - b. Covanta Haverhill, request dated November 29, 2018, for a 3-month extension of the inspectional requirement for MA069124.
  - c. Chelsea Soldiers Home, request dated December 17, 2018, for a 90-day extension of the inspectional requirement for MA071484.
  - d. Calpine Fore River Generation Station, request dated January 8, 2019, for a 2-month extension of the inspectional requirement for MA103840, MA119022 and MA119023.
  - e. Pinetree Power Fitchburg, Inc., request dated February 6, 2019, for a 2-month extension of the inspectional requirement for MA068133.
  - f. Exelon Mystic 8 & 9, request dated February 9, 2019, for a 70-day extension of the inspectional requirement for MA103073 and MA103139.
  - g. Angelica Corporation, request dated January 31, 2019, for a 2-month extension of the inspectional requirement for MA116198.
  - h. ANP Blackstone Energy Co, request dated February 15, 2019, for a 30-day extension of the inspectional requirement for MA068631.
  - i. Saint-Gobain, request dated March 12, 2019, for a 1-month extension of the inspectional requirement for MA068254.

5. 522 CMR Committee Report: The Chairman reminded the Board that the 522 CMR Committee had been tasked by the Board in October to review the current standards adopted by the Board for 522 CMR, and asked the Chairman, Anthony Lucia, of the Committee to report back to the Board. Anthony Lucia read to the Board the memorandum submitted by the Committee summarizing their findings. In conducting this review, the Committee considered summaries of the most recent edition of each of the codes listed in 522 CMR 1.03. The Committee made the following recommendations:
- That the Board adopt the most current editions of those standards contained in 522 CMR 1.03, as outlined in the attached table of revisions, which includes NBIC Part 4, Pressure Relief Devices.
  - That the Board adopt ASME CSD-1, and conduct a review of 522 CMR 16 in reference to CSD-1 and the applicable scope.
  - That the Board adopt an accepted definition of Authority Having Jurisdiction (AHJ) in 522 CMR 1.02.

The Committee did not review ASME Sections III or XI, as these sections were not available for review. The Board Chairman clarified that Sections III and XI are related to nuclear devices, and were therefore not reviewed. Regarding the second recommendation made by the Committee, the Board Chairman stated that the Board currently adopts Part CW, Steam & Waterside Controls, and asked that the Board consider also adopting the General Requirements section of the CSD-1. He explained that Part CG is the General Requirements section, which includes the scope of this standard. Regarding the third recommendation made by the Committee, the Board Chairman recommended that DFS staff provide a suggested definition for the Board to consider at the next meeting. The Board was provided with a copy of the list of those

codes/standards adopted in 522 CMR 1.03 including the last date adopted, and the latest edition date of each code.
