3. Review of 2021 Edition of ASME BPV Code, and the new 2021 Section VIII, Rules for Overpressure Protection: The Chairman turned the meeting over to Supervisor Dan Laperle.

Administrative Services • Division of Fire Safety Hazardous Materials Response • Massachusetts Firefighting Academy Supervisor Laperle presented the Redline version of the ASME BPVC, and summarized the changes in the 2021 Edition of each section. He reminded the Committee members that although *Section III/Rules for Construction for Nuclear Facility Components* and *Section XI/Rules for Inservice Inspection of Nuclear Power Plant Components* are included in 1.03, these sections will not be reviewed by the Committee. Also, *Section X/Fiber-reinforced Plastic Pressure Vessels*, which is not available on the Techstreet subscription, will not be reviewed.

The new Section XIII/Rules for Overpressure Protection, ASME is basically following the NBIC.
