Orange Lantern Inc. d/b/a Magic Lantern (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("Commission" or "ABCC") held a hearing on Tuesday, October 1, 2019, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch.138 § 34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigator Quinn's Report.

FACTS

- 1. On Saturday, July 20, 2019, at approximately 2:01 p.m., Investigators Kujawski and Quinn ("Investigators") investigated the business of Orange Lantern Inc. d/b/a Magic Lantern.
- 2. An underage operative, working with Investigators, purchased from the Licensee an alcoholic beverage, a draft Bud Light beer for four dollars and twenty-five cents (\$4.25). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2)- Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. Ch.138 § 34- Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. The Commission issues a **WARNING**.
