



Massachusetts Offers Rebates for Electric Vehicle (MOR-EV) Program

The **Massachusetts Clean Cities Coalition (MA CCC)** and the Department of Energy Resources (DOER) **Emerging Technology Department** are looking to engage with Environmental Justice communities and stakeholders, virtually, on the **MOR-EV Trucks program enhancement proposal**.

As part of the State's commitment to reducing greenhouse gas emissions and expanding access to zero-emission vehicle adoption, **DOER** intends to revise the **MOR-EV program** to provide rebates to private (personal & commercial) purchases of electric medium and heavy-duty (MD/HD) trucks.
