What is MOSES?

Massachusetts One-Stop Employment System

- One-Stop approach that is required by the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA)
 - Wagner-Peyser Services (WIA Title III)
 - Intensive Services for Dislocated Workers, Adults and Youth (WIOA Title I)
 - UI Profiled, Section 30 Eligible, REA / RES Program
 - National Dislocated Worker Grants
 - Trade Adjustment Assistance Program
 - Rapid Response Program
 - Department of Transitional Assistance

Came from Indiana

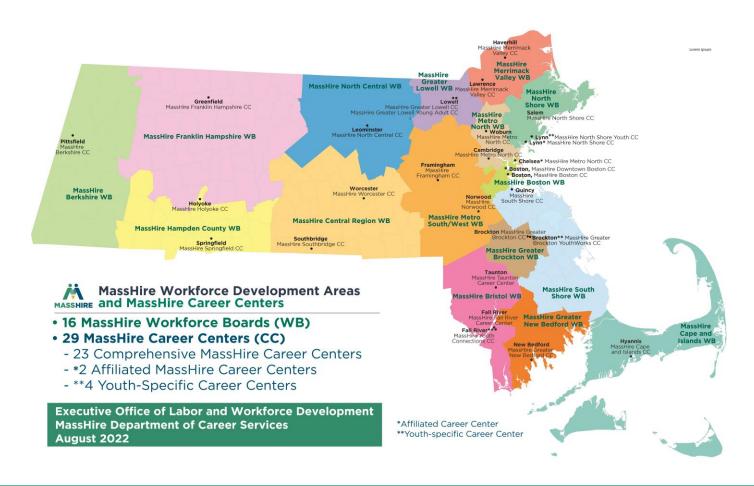


Launched / went live in Career Centers July 5, 2000

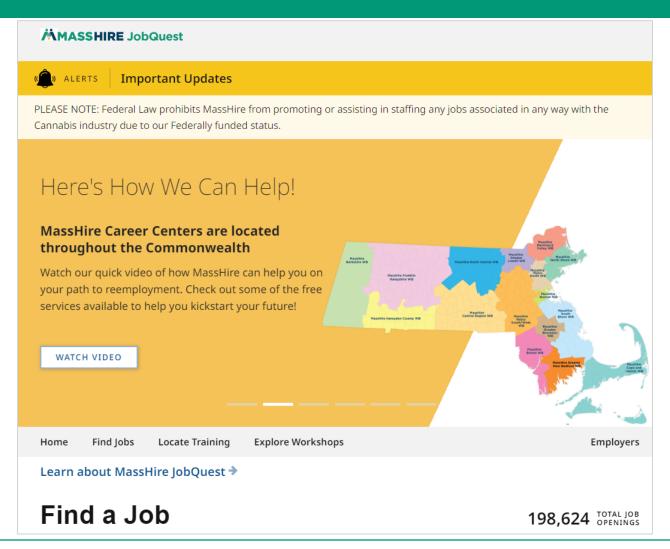
