MOSES *Text Only* Revisions

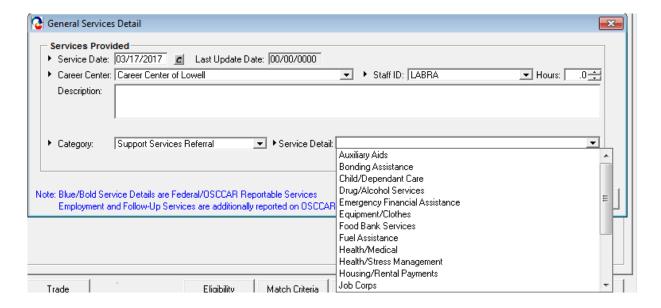
As a first pass towards compliance with <u>TEGL 10-16</u>, Performance Accountability Guidance for WIOA, revisions to the job seeker services and funding source maintenance screens on MOSES have been made. Further changes will be made shortly to ensure complete compliance.

Changes to General Services

Addition of a new service category - Support Services Referrals.

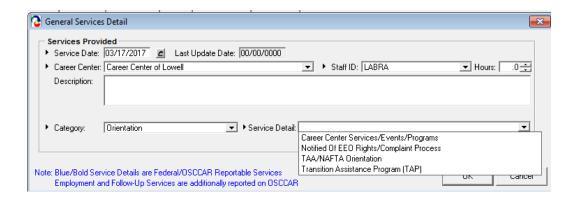
TEGL 10-16 differentiates between *delivering* a support service (blue/bold service) and *referring to* a support service (not blue/bold). If your agency is paying for a support service; i.e. *delivering* the support service (e.g. purchasing equipment for a youth program), then use the blue/bold *Supportive Service* category. If you are solely referring a job seeker to a support service agency (e.g. Fuel Assistance) then you should use the new *Support Service Referral* category.

New Support Service Referral Category



Orientation Service Category No Longer Blue/Bold

All *Orientation* services are no longer blue/bold; that is they will not restart the *90 day clock* for auto exit. The TEGL is clear to say that Orientation services, while important services to a job seeker, do not trigger or extend participation.



Added a new H1B Funding Source Grant Type

A new *Grant Type* has been established in MOSES for the *Funding Sources Maintenance* screen, named *H1B*. The new Tech Hire/MASSAMTC funding is of that type. Make sure to use this new grant type when setting up any new funding source where the funding is from H1B funds.
