Background: The release date to the field for MOSES 36.2 is Wednesday, June 28, 2017.

This will be a weekday night-time build.

MOSES will be shut down at 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 27, 2017 for the updates and the maintenance of the MOSES software and MOSES Applications (JobQuest / TrainingPro).

This will **NOT** interrupt other IT services or functions to the offices, only MOSES will be taken off-line. Email, unemployment assistance systems and internet services will still be available.

Please plan on completing and saving your MOSES data entry by 4:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 27, and then log off MOSES. This will ensure that when you log into MOSES on Wednesday, June 28, you will have the new version of MOSES available and any work done prior will be saved.


Description of Key Changes in MOSES Version 36.2

Job Orders: The FLC Status on Job Orders is not updateable through Staff View.

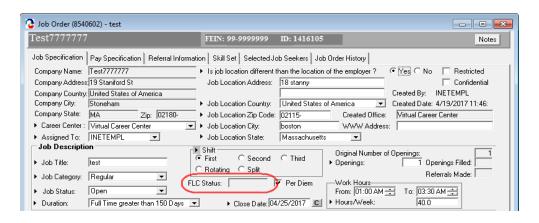
• When a Job Order is created through the FLC Application, FLC Status will display 'H2A' or 'H2B'.



• Adding a Job Order through Staff View – the FLC Status field will be set to 'None' and not updatable.

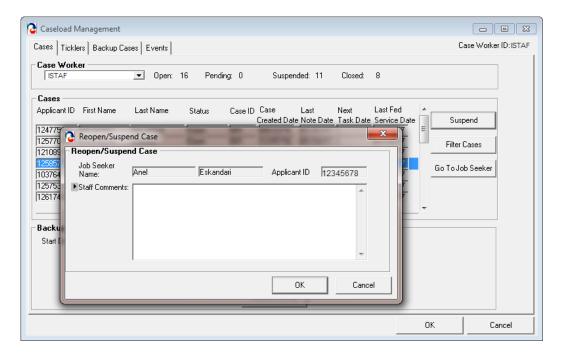


 Job Orders created through JobQuest or jobs that come in through a Job feed will display blank in FLC Status.



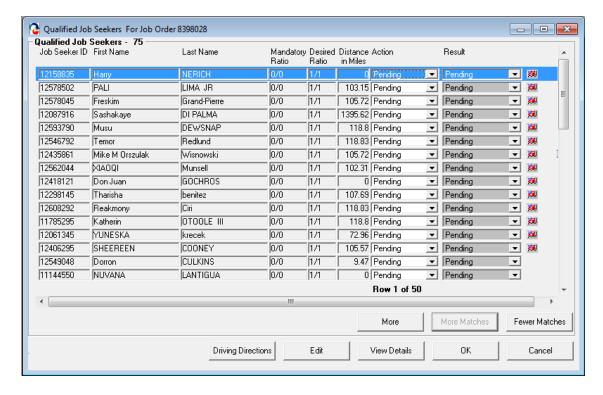
Caseload Management -

• Reopen/Suspend Case screen is updated to display Applicant ID instead of Social Security Number



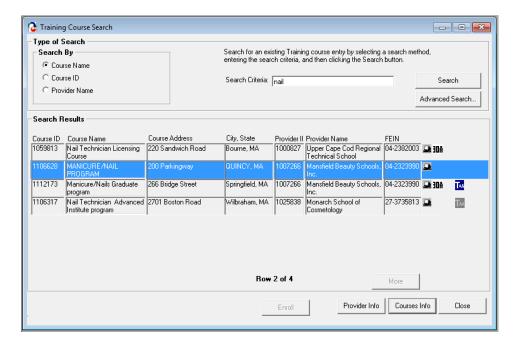
Job Order - Run Match - Search Results

When you do a Run Match on a Job Order, the Job Seeker ID will now be displayed.



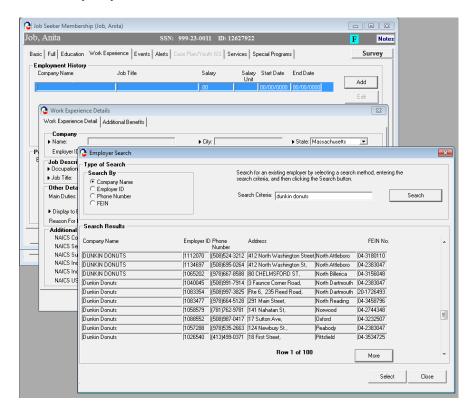
Training Course Search –

• New City, State column added. Allows you to search easier for training courses by City location.



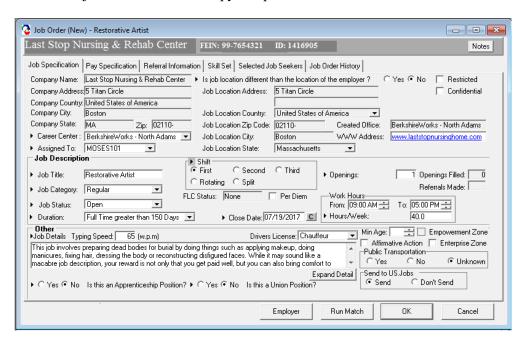
Job Seeker – Work Experience tab – Adding Work History – Employer Search - Employer results broken out by City
