Whereas, Numerous organizations are committed to making our streets and highways safe for all motor vehicle-related transportation, including MassDOT's Highway Division and the Registry of Motor Vehicles and its Massachusetts Rider Education Program, the EOPSS Highway Safety Division, the American Motorcyclists Association, the Motorcycle Safety Foundation, the Massachusetts Motorcycle Association, and many motorcycle businesses and clubs in Massachusetts,




MOTORCYCLE SAFETY AWARENESS PERIOD


And urge all residents of the Commonwealth to take cognizance of this event and participate fittingly in its observance.
