

Massachusetts and U.S. Disability Facts & Statistics: 2019

- In 2018, there were 6,902,149 individuals living in the community in Massachusetts, of which 791,132 were persons with disabilities; a prevalence rate of 11.6%.
- In 2018, there were 322,249,485 individuals living in the community in the U.S., of which 40,637,764 were persons with disabilities; a prevalence rate of 12.6%.
- In 2018, 26.1% of individuals with disabilities living in the community in the US were below the poverty line, in Massachusetts this rate in 2018 was 25.3%, compared to 10.7% of individuals without disabilities in the US, and 7.9% in Massachusetts.
