2. Hearing on 2024MSAC00133 (Respondent Alex Sepulveda)

The respondent Alex Sepulveda was present for the hearing and asked the Commission to postpone the hearing to allow him time to retain counsel. After a brief discussion, Commissioner Navien made a motion to postpone this hearing until the August 13th MSAC meeting, which was seconded by Commissioner Miller. A roll call vote was conducted and the motion passed unanimously.

3. Hearing on 2024MSAC00060 (Respondent Rami Ibrahim)

The respondent Rami Ibrahim was present for the hearing. Commissioner Zakim opened the hearing and Prosecutor Seth Henderson presented the facts to the Commission. Mr. Ibrahim was allowed to respond to the facts presented by the Prosecutor. After a lengthy conversation with Mr. Ibrahim, Commissioner Navien made a motion to find that this violation has not been proved. This motion was seconded by Commissioner Kelly. A roll call vote was conducted and the motion passed unanimously.
