RE: Wheelabrator Mercury Separation Plan MSP 8 Extension Request

Dear Ms. Zemba:

Wheelabrator Millbury, North Andover and Saugus have been operating the Mercury Separation Plan 8 (MSP 8) revision since January 1, 2023. These plans typically have a 2-year lifecycle and are periodically revised or extended. MSP 8 was recently revised based on discussions with the Department on what modifications could be made that can provide a more value added return on the money spent on the various components of the plans.

To that end, MassDEP and WIN Waste Innovations agree to extend MSP 8 to December 2027. Current budget allocations within each plan will remain the same. An additional component was added to the plans to support outreach and education on the proper management of lithium-ion batteries that are being discarded. As of this writing, the plans for each facility have been revised and submitted to the Department for review and approval.
