Disability Employment Subcommittee:

- Employment is an important part of the Commission's mission.
- Gathered data on how increased earnings effect public benefits.
- Created a resource for employers and produced a promotional video.
- Co-hosted a networking and resource-sharing event at the State House.
- Participated in the MA-APSE Annual Employment Matters Conference
- Future planning

Workforce Supports Subcommittee:

- Reviewed the Center for Health Information and Analysis and national data to pinpoint severe staffing shortages and their impact on service access.
- Met with the Executive Office of Health and Human Services to track major workforce investments in training, loan repayment, and education pipelines, while identifying remaining gaps.
- Highlighted findings from the Administration for Community Living and the Direct Care
 Workforce Strategies Center on turnover, low pay, and barriers facing a diverse
 workforce.
- Engaged with the Attorney General's Office on immigrant worker rights, wage enforcement, and workforce stability.
- Future planning: Continue gathering data and stories, advance solutions for recruitment and retention, and align efforts with broader Commission priorities.

Long Term Services and Supports & Health Equity Subcommittee:

- Reviewed Medicaid & LTSS Landscape: Collaborated with MassHealth leadership to understand the impact of federal funding cuts, rising PCA program costs, and strategies to sustain community-based services.
- Hosted Health Equity Hearing: Brought together state leaders, providers and advocates to discuss barriers and solutions for more equitable care.
- Following MassHealth's new Quality & Equity Incentive Program and progress on health equity goals that promote data transparency, disability competency training, and system-wide accountability.
- Looking Ahead: Continue bringing in experts, monitoring Medicaid changes, and connecting work across LTSS, housing, and health equity.
