1. <u>Meeting Opening and Introductions</u>

Chief Matthew Belsito, Chairman, opened the meeting at approximately 10:09 a.m. The Chair introduced himself, followed by the introductions of the Council members, Department of Fire Services' employees, and public members in attendance.

4. <u>Subcommittee Reports</u>

- a. Equipment No one present from this team
- b. Membership Deputy Manning indicated there was no meeting this month, trying to get a meeting scheduled in May to finish application and application scoring tool.
- c. Training Vice Chair McGregor indicated that the team didn't meet this month, they are trying to find dates that work in May.

5. <u>Regional Reports</u>

- a. Region 1 No one present
- b. Region 2 Bob Bottary gave an update on Boston Fire. They had their typical responses for elevator blind shaft and water rescues. Spent 2 weeks training with the MBTA on lifting trolleys with their new air bags. Did some blind shaft elevator training on a 200-foot blind shaft. Water training on the Charles is in progress. Paul Morrison stated Quincy continues to train up a dive team. Somerville conducted a confined space & rope rescue drill at a 1-million-gallon water cistern. Cambridge did their monthly dive training. They are currently deployed in Andover for a missing child, working with Boston Fire and Mass State Police. Next week they will be conducting a 1-day structural collapse refresher for each group. May 21st they will be doing a joint drill at a water treatment plant on Deer Island doing an elaborate rope rescue drill. Tower training to come in the summer. Francis Otting commented that they are waiting on federal DHS funding for UASI, no update at this time.
- c. Region 3 Jon Martin stated D7 had a joint swift water and tech rescue drill utilizing high lines and boat work. They had no call outs this month.
