#### **Small Business Purchasing Program (SBPP)**




Goal: Increase spending with small businesses

**Purchasing:** Use small businesses to the extent possible based on contract terms, departmental policies, laws and regulations.

RFQs and Open-Market Procurements (≤\$250K/year): Award to a Massachusetts-based small business that meets the department's best value criteria.

#### **Small Business Purchasing Program (SBPP)**





Apply through the Supplier Diversity Office <u>Portal</u>, with Department of Revenue verification:

- Principal place of business in Massachusetts;
- Business operating for at least one year;
- Currently employs a combined total of 50 or fewer full-time equivalents in all locations;
- Gross annual revenues of \$15 million or less based on a 3-year average



The SBPP applies to Massachusetts executive agencies, as well as entities that voluntarily participate in the program.





Goal: Increase participation of diverse businesses

**Purchasing:** Buy from diverse businesses to the extent possible based on contract terms, departmental policies, laws and regulations.

**Open-Market Procurements (>\$250K/year):** Require prime bidders and contractors to maintain partnerships with diverse businesses.

## Eligible Certification Categories

- MBE: Minority-Owned Business Enterprise
- **WBE**: Women-Owned Business Enterprise
- VBE: Veteran Business Enterprise
- SDVOBE: Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned Business Enterprises
- DOBE: Disability-Owned Business Enterprise
- LGBTBE: Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender Business Enterprise



The SDP applies to Massachusetts executive agencies, as well as entities that voluntarily participate in the program.

#### Municipal Construction Affirmative Marketing Program (MCAMP)

 The SDO sets project-specific MBE and WBE participation goals in the design and construction phases for state & state-assisted projects

#### Veteran Business Goal

- The SDO has set a 3% VBE participation goal for all state & state-assisted design and construction projects
- Both programs apply to projects valued at \$150,000 or more
- The SDO monitors and assists municipalities & general contractors with attaining these goals

**Empowering Abilities in Contracting and Employment (EACE)** 

- Expand inclusion of Disability-owned and Service-Disabled Veteran-owned businesses in public purchasing
- Assist vendors on statewide contracts to promote and retain employees with disabilities
- Further develop resources and tools for employers and individuals with disabilities seeking employment

## Developing Your Supplier Diversity Program



#### **Program Implementation - Three Avenues**





#### **Purchasing & Quoting**

- Available immediately
- Easy to understand and communicate
- Requires minimal procedural changes
- Perfect as the first step



#### **Contracts and Procurement**

- Available with your next planned procurement
- Requires additional effort in marketing business opportunities
- If effective, newly-awarded contractors add to the options available for purchasing



#### **Fostering Partnerships**

- Available with your next planned procurement
- Requires changes to contract language and bid evaluation procedures
- Requires additional effort in contractor reporting and compliance management

Look at the current contracts you are using and buy from diverse vendors already on contract

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

- Identifying diverse vendors for your next procurement
- Marketing your bid to diverse and small vendors
- Facilitating a vendor readiness session

#### **Imagine Yourself as a First-Time Bidder**

#### What does the bid solicitation look like? Consider reducing the...

- Number of separate documents
- Number of separate forms to complete
- Total number of pages to read

#### What is the bidder required to send back? Consider providing...

A clear list of all required documents in one place

#### Is it clear how to get help? Consider...

- A presentation on the scope, requirements and response expectations
- Training on how to submit a response

#### Are the requirements realistic for a small business? Consider...

- Unbundling the scope or splitting it into categories
- Reworking essential requirements (e.g. number of years in business, government client experience vs. institutional client experience, etc.)

#### Will the vendor hear back from you? Consider...

 Ensuring that each bidder hears from you regarding the results of the solicitation







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#### **Fostering Partnerships**

- Pursuant to <u>Executive Order 599</u>, the <u>Supplier Diversity Program</u> (SDP) promotes business-to-business relationships between awarded Contractors and diverse businesses
- Consider including supplier diversity in contract language which requires vendors to set up partnerships with certified diverse vendors\*
- Bidders are required to make a financial commitment to partnering with one or more SDO-certified or recognized diverse business enterprise(s)
- The SDO is happy to meet with you to discuss options

#### **Program Implementation**

**Step-by-Step: Contracts and Procurement** 

Action	Description
1) Focus	Focus on an upcoming business opportunity or purchasing need.
2) Simplify	Identify and remove barriers that diverse and small suppliers may experience in bidding.
3) Target	Identify eligible diverse suppliers that may be capable of providing the product/service.
4) Market	Market the opportunity to eligible diverse suppliers.
5) Procure	Conduct a competitive procurement in accordance with applicable laws and regulations.
6) Inform	Inform purchasing staff of newly available diverse suppliers and the process for ordering from them.
7) Track	Track your organization's spending with diverse suppliers.

Supplier Diversity Office

The SDO Cross Functional Team can help identify diverse vendors, send marketing emails, and facilitate vendor readiness sessions to answer questions about the bidding process.
