<b>Small Estate Closing Statement §3-1204</b>	Yes.	Yes, one year after the closing statement is filed provided no actions or proceedings involving the PR are pending in the Court.	Yes, for 1 year by filing a Petition for Complete Settlement . Thereafter, only for fraud or manifest error.	No.
<b>Closing Statement §3-1003</b>	Yes.	No.	Yes , for 1 year by filing a Petition for Complete Settlement . Thereafter, only for fraud or manifest error.	No.
<b>Petition for Complete Settlement of Estate §3-1001</b>	Yes.	No.	No, except for fraud or manifest error.	Yes, as to all issues determined in the Order of Complete Settlement.
