PUBLIC NOTICE OF A DRAFT HAZARDOUS WASTE MANAGEMENT FACILITY LICENSE AND OPTIONAL PUBLIC HEARING RELATIVE THERETO PURSUANT TO MASSACHUSETTS GENERAL LAW CHAPTER 21C AND MASSACHUSETTS HAZARDOUS WASTE REGULATIONS, 310 CMR 30.000.

NAME AND LOCATION OF FACILITY:

Murphy's Waste Oil Service, Inc. 252 Salem Street Woburn, MA 01801

PROPOSED:

Murphy's Waste Oil Service, Inc. is an existing hazardous waste facility operating under the terms of a Hazardous Waste License #23B/2018 issued by the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) on September 27, 2018. The company proposes to continue its operation and has applied for a five-year license renewal from the Department. A Draft License has been issued by the Department. Pursuant to the public participation requirements in 310 CMR 30.800, the public has forty-five days to comment on the Draft License.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Any member of the public wishing to comment on the Draft License may file written comments during the public comment period that will extend from August 7, 2024 to September 21, 2024.

Pursuant to 310 CMR 30.837 (1), if during the comment period or within 15 days of the close of the comment period the Department receives written notice requesting a public hearing or it determines on its own that there is significant public interest in the Draft License, the Department will schedule an informal public hearing on the proposed action. Written and oral comments will be accepted at the hearing.

A Fact Sheet describing the licensing process, the company, its operation, and terms and conditions of this license is available for review at the Woburn Board of Health, the Woburn Public Library, the Department's Wilmington and Boston Offices and the USEPA New England - Region I Office in Boston, and on the MassDEP website at MassDEP Public Hearings & Comment Opportunities | Mass.gov under MassDEP Permits & Approvals. Anyone wishing to examine the Draft License may do so at these locations.

FINAL DECISION:

The Department will consider all written comments received during the comment period, all comments received at a hearing, if held, and the requirements of the Massachusetts Hazardous Waste Regulations, 310 CMR 30.000. The Department will then make a final decision regarding the issuance of a hazardous waste license to Murphy's Waste Oil Service, Inc. A notice of the final license decision will be sent to the applicant and to each person who has submitted written comments or has otherwise requested notice of the final license decision. If no comments requesting a change in the Draft License are received, a final license decision will become effective 21 (twenty-one) days after the date of the notice of the decision. The final license decision will be postponed if a request for an adjudicatory hearing before the Department is made within the 21-day period.
