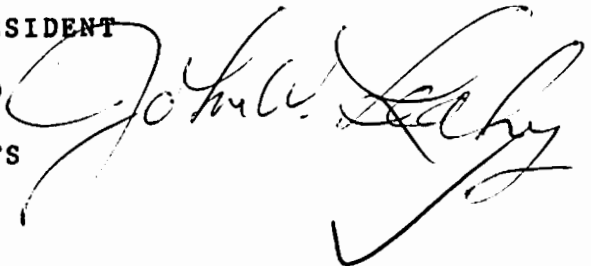

RULES GOVERNING TARIFF

1. Shipper to load and provide all necessary material for loading and be responsible for same.
2. Minimum load is 40,000 (20 Tons).
3. Material delivered F.O.B. truck site of job or nearest accessible point.
- 4P. One (1) hour free time will be allowed for loading or picking up load and one (1) hour free time for unloading. After the expiration of the free time, demurrage shall accrue at the rate of five dollars and fifty cents (\$5.50) for each fifteen (15) minutes or fractions thereof, the motor carrier is delayed, due to conditions over which the carrier has no control.
5. Rejections or over shipments on a job will be hauled back by trucks delivering to the same job at one half ($\frac{1}{2}$) the rate set forth in this tariff. If trucks are dispatched expressly to pick up and bring back rejected or over shipments, the rate will be the full rate set forth in this tariff.
- 6P. The rate for a tractor to pick up empty trailers will be thirty dollars (\$30.00) per hours up to eight (8) hours and forty-eight dollars (\$48.00) over eight (8) hours.
- 7P. The rate for a tractor to work at a job site return an empty oversize trailer or to haul a San-Vel trailer with miscellaneous material used in connection and erection will be thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) per hour, from the time the vehicle leaves the garage until its return thereto, less meals and breakdowns, up to eight (8) hours, and forty-eight dollars (\$48.00) over eight (8) hours.
- 8P. The rate for a tractor and regular trailer to haul miscellaneous material used in connection and erection will be forty dollars (\$40.00) per hour, from the time the vehicle leaves the garage until its return thereto, less meals and breakdowns, up to eight (8) hours, and fifty-three dollars (\$53.00) over eight (8) hours.
- 9P. The rate for a tractor and extendible or drop frame trailer to haul miscellaneous material used in connection and erection will be forty-seven dollars (\$47.00) per hour, from the time the vehicle leaves the garage until its return thereto, less meals and breakdowns, up to eight (8) hours, and sixty dollars (\$60.00) per hour over eight (8) hours.
10. When deliveries are required on Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays, or nights, there will be an extra charge of Sixteen dollars (\$16.00) per hours, for each man required with a minimum charge of one-hundred-twenty-eight dollars (\$128.00) per man required.

RULES GOVERNING TARIFF (CONT.)

- 11P. When, because of the size of material being moved, guide cars are required, they will be charged for at the rate of twenty-two dollars and fifty cents (\$22.50) per hour, from the time the vehicle leaves the garage until its return thereto, less meals and breakdowns.
12. Charges for tolls and permits will be the cost of obtaining the required permits, the cost of permits and tolls plus 10% for the overhead expenses, with a minimum charge of five dollars (\$5.00) per load.
13. Trailers that are loaded for more than five (5) working days whether in the yard or on a job will be charged for at the following rates:

Regular platform trailers \$15.00 per day.

Extendible or drop frame trailers \$25.00 per day.

- Column A** Rates apply on prestressed and precast concrete products up to and including forty-five feet (45') in length, and up to and including eight feet (8') in width, and up to and including eight feet and six inches (8'6") in height.
- Column B** Rates apply on prestressed and precast concrete products over forty-five feet (45') up to and including sixty-five feet (65') in length, over eight feet (8') up to and including ten feet (10') in width, and over eight feet and six inches (8'6") up to and including eight feet and nine inches (8'9") in height.
- Column C** Rates apply on prestressed and precast concrete products over sixty-five feet (65') to what ever length will go on extendible trailers, over ten feet (10') up to and including twelve feet (12') in width or height.
