


















VISUAL COUNT ALL YEARS





VIDEO COUNT ALL YEARS



Video system estimates vs. Visual Count estimates, 2017-2024






Video system estimates vs. Visual Count estimates, 2017-2023, May-Jun

LESSONS LEARNED

Video system estimates vs. Visual Count estimates

- Video system captures a lot, especially large scale patterns
- But water clarity and reliability can limit the video system's ability to capture
- The Visual Count with DMF is still our Gold Standard.
- Both are great outreach and education opportunities.
