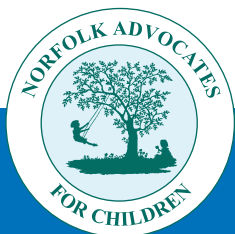

This program is partially supported by MOVA through the 1984 Voca grant from OVC, OJP, U.S., DOJ and is a free service.



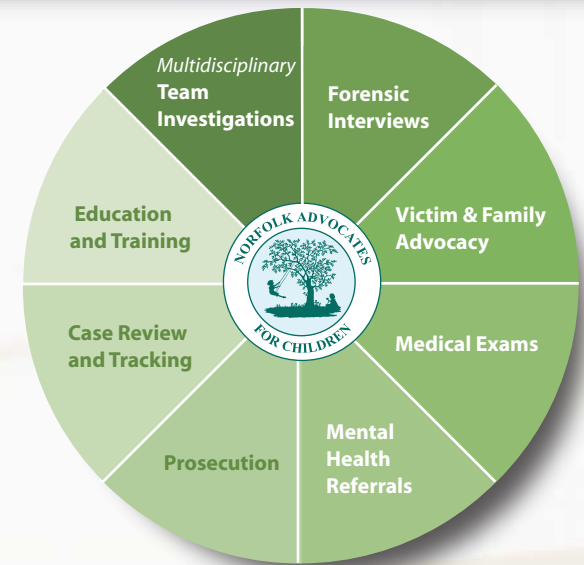
