Member will learn about "DPPC" by being able to expressively answer with what the acronym stands for and what the organization does for them with 100% accuracy across 4 consecutive opportunities. Member will learn to identify safe and unsafe situations with 100% accuracy across 4 consecutive opportunities. Member will identify safe and unsafe situations and tell their therapist an appropriate solution as to how they could solve the issue with 100% accuracy across 4 opportunities. Member will discriminate between known individuals and strangers and identify whether they can go with them or not with 100% accuracy for 4 consecutive opportunities. After learning about the function of DPPC, member will expressively be able to identify what abuse or neglect is with 100% accuracy across 4 consecutive opportunities. Member will determine what a mandated reporter is and who in their life is a mandated reporter and will do with 100% accuracy across 4 consecutive opportunities.
