DECISION

NICHOLAS'S RESTAURANT GROUP INC. D/B/A MORSE TAVERN 85 EAST CENTRAL ST.
NATICK, MA 01760

Nicholas's Restaurant Group Inc. d/b/a Morse Tavern (the "Licensee") holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (the "Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, November 15, 2016, regarding an alleged violation of 204 CMR 2.05 (2) – Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the Licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Carey's Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

- 1. Investigator Carey's Compliance Check Field Report dated May 17, 2016;
- 2. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

The Commission took Administrative Notice of the Licensee's record.

FACTS

- 1. On Tuesday, May 17, 2016, at approximately 7:09 p.m., Investigators Temple and Carey investigated the business operation of Nicholas's Restaurant Group Inc. d/b/a Morse Tavern.
- 2. An underage operative, working with Investigators, purchased from the Licensee an alcoholic beverage, a 22 ounce Coors Light beer for five dollars and thirty-four cents (\$5.34). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence the Commission finds the Licensee violated 204 CMR 2.05 (2) - Permitting an illegality on the licensed premises, to wit: M.G.L. c. 138, §34 – Sale or delivery of an alcoholic beverage to a person under twenty-one (21) years of age. As the Licensee has been in business for more than 10 years with no prior violations, the Commission issues a **WARNING**.
