**Background:** Observed each October, NDEAM is a national campaign that celebrates individuals with disabilities and their contributions and achievements to America's workforce. Reflecting the important role that different perspectives play in workforce success, the Office of Disability Employment Policy (ODEP) created this year's theme with input from a wide variety of its partner organizations, including those representing employers, people with disabilities and their families, and federal, state, and local agencies.
