Daily, 9:00 am– 4:00 pm.	Visitor Center open. Natural Bridge State Park Visitor Center features exhibits and park and tourist information, restrooms, and drinking water. Open daily, late-May through mid-October.
Thursdays, 10:00– 11:00 am.	Nice & Easy Walk. Join the park interpreter for a leisurely exercise walk, under a mile, geared for older adults, but open to all. Enjoy some informal, on-the-go interpretation. Dress for the weather. Wear sturdy shoes. Bring a water bottle. Meet at the Visitor Center.
Fridays, 11:00 am– 12:00 pm.	Tremendous Tree Walk - Fall Foliage. An easy, interpreter-guided walk along the 0.6-mile-long Elder Nature Trail. Encounter wonderful trees in a landscape shaped by glacial forces and human agriculture, and now, as they reveal their colorful autumn splendor All ages. Wear sturdy footwear. Bring a water bottle. Meet at the Visitor Center.
Fridays & Saturdays, 1:00– 3:00 pm.	Investigation Station. All ages. Visit with the Park Interpreter in or just outside the Visitor Center to get a closer, fun, informative glimpse into local plants, wildlife, geology, and history. Topics rotate weekly. Stay for a few minutes or an hour.
Thursdays, 2:30 pm. Saturdays, 10:00 am, & 11:00 am. Sundays & Mondays, 10:00 am, 11:00 am, 1:00 pm, & 2:30 pm.	Natural Bridge History Tour. For all ages. Easy, 0.2-mile, 45-min. walking tour to discover the natural and cultural mysteries of the chasm and quarry. Interpreter-guided discovery with short stories that enliven and highlight this unique park! Wear sturdy shoes. Bring water. All ages. Meet outside the Visitor Center.
