DECISION

Cerrito's Inc. dba Acapulco's Mexican Family Restaurant ("The Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c.138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("The Commission") held a hearing on August 17, 2010 regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c.138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Brad Doyle's Compliance Check Field Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Licensee's Stipulation of Facts; and
2. Compliance Check Field Report of Investigator Brad Doyle.

Facts

1. On, June 8, 2010 at approximately 7:04 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation Cerrito's Inc. dba Acapulco's Mexican Family Restaurant.
2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a bottle of Corona for \$5.00. The underage operative was not asked for identification.

Conclusion

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated M.G.L. c.138, §34. The Commission **suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.**
