Disaster Finance

NEMTEC's First Created Course <u>Now</u> <u>Available</u>, More in Production

Several half-day virtual courses are being developed, Disaster Finance is now complete. This course highlights the financial considerations and best practices during disaster preparation, response, and recovery. The target audience includes New England local government: emergency management directors, finance directors, accountants, auditors, procurement officers, and other members of the finance team. The next course to be finalized is COOP For Local Governments, expected to be available in April.

Basic Academy Courses Available Virtually

The Basic Academy courses are now available with a virtual instructor-led option. NEMTEC is offering the Basic Academy in 4-hour blocks of instruction. Attendance to all classes in a series is required to receive course credit. In-Person options are still available.
