Recently a training needs assessment was conducted by NEMTEC to poll a diverse cross-section of emergency management stakeholders throughout New England to guide the development and delivery of training. Thank you to all participants, we received responses from over 550 organizations. The survey results were analyzed and the findings included in

a report. Three conclusions include: 1. capability gaps span all aspects of emergency management, 2. Training programs must be of high value, relevant, concise and accessible, and 3. Trainings must be offered in multiple modalities and scheduled times. The <u>full report</u> is available online.

Disaster Finance Update

Curriculum development is progressing for NEMTEC's next course offering.


An early finding of the training needs assessment showed a capability gap in disaster finance. Early this year a NEMTEC curriculum development team, working with New England subject matter experts, started working on a 4-hour course to be delivered virtually. A partial pilot of the course was delivered to New England state training officers and other stakeholders in June. The course is well on its way and will be delivered this fiscal year.

Expanding Virtual Training Opportunities

The report findings of the recent NEMTEC needs assessment showed a preference for offering training in multiple modalities, and a need to expand our virtual presence. NEMTEC is also evaluating the Basic Academy courses to determine how to best adapt portions or all curriculum to a virtual platform. To facilitate this move we are in the process of expanding our cadre of virtual instructors.
