DECISION

OLD INN ON THE GREEN, LLC DBA THE OLD INN ON THE GREEN
NORTH ROAD, RTE 57
NEW MARLBOROUGH, MA 01230

Old Inn on the Green, LLC dba The Old Inn on the Green (the "Licensee") holds an all alcohol license issued pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws chapter 138, §12. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission ("the Commission") held a hearing on Tuesday, September 13, 2011, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Prior to the commencement of the hearing, the licensee stipulated to the violation alleged in Investigator Jack Carey's Compliance Check Field Report.

2. Compliance Check Field Report of Investigator Jack Carey.

FACTS


1. On, June 8, 2011 at approximately 6:30 p.m., Commission Investigators investigated the business operation Old Inn on the Green, LLC dba The Old Inn on the Green.
2. An underage operative, working with the investigators, purchased a beer bottle for six dollars and thirty eight cents (\$6.38). The underage operative was not asked for identification.

CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the licensee violated M.G.L. c. 138, §34. Therefore, the Commission **suspends the license for three (3) days of which three (3) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations occur.**


