**Purpose:** To notify Local Workforce Investment Boards, One-Stop Career Center Operators

and other local workforce investment partners of the new website for the Massachusetts Workforce System (www.mass.gov/massworkforce).

**Background:** The Massachusetts Department of Career Services (DCS) maintains a website for administrators and staff of the Commonwealth's One-Stop Career Centers and

partner organizations. Beginning **June 1, 2014** DCS will begin the transition from the current site (<a href="www.massworkforce.org">www.massworkforce.org</a>) to a new location on the Mass.gov platform (<a href="mass.gov/massworkforce">Mass.gov/massworkforce</a>).
