Day 1 Uniform of the Day

- Black baseball cap
- Solid white t-shirt (under khaki shirt)
- Long sleeve khaki shirt with tie and tie bar (October 15-April 14); Short sleeve khaki shirt without tie (April 15- October 14)
- Silver name tag centered 1/4" above top seam of right shirt pocket
- Khaki pants
- Black leather belt with silver buckle
- White socks
- Black Leather Boots (NO ZIPPERS) Shined
- 2 Silver black ink pens in upper left shirt pocket
- 1 Pocket notebook secured in upper left shirt pocket
- Water bottle (filled with ONLY water)
- Duffel Bag containing all equipment listed in Standard Equipment List: Day One

Unless indicated, all clothing items must be a solid color. There should be no logos, insignia, markings, tags or branding visible from the outside. All items with specified colors must match. For example, 4 Black short-sleeved PT shirts must all be the same shade of black. Everything must be labeled and marked according to the instructions provided in the "Details" section of the list above. All items without specific lettering instructions must be clearly labeled with the recruit's name in black or white permanent ink.

Firearms

DO NOT bring any firearms, ammunition, knives, or related equipment to the academy on day 1 or any day thereafter, unless authorized by the Academy Director.

All firearms, ammunition, and knives are prohibited on academy property – including storage inside personal or patrol vehicles.

Departments are encouraged to contact the Academy Director, prior to obtaining the required ammunition, as adjustments to ammunition may be necessary. All firearms are subject to inspection and approval by MPTC.

Note: Recruits are required to have a valid license to carry a firearm when transporting weapons. This includes to and from the academy and firearms range.

Patrol Vehicles

The MPTC does not provide vehicles for ROC training. Marked patrol cars are required for skill development exercises to include EVOC, motor vehicle stops, and patrol duties. The Academy Director will provide specific dates for when patrol cars are needed.

One (1) marked vehicle is required for every two (2) recruits. Departments sponsoring more than two (2) recruits must still meet this ratio.

Patrol Vehicle Requirements

- Engine in good running condition
- Four (4) tires with ample tread and no defects
- Working head, tail and turn signal lights
- Working emergency lights and siren
- Tire pressure gauge
- Full spare tire with jack & lug wrench (secured in trunk). All other items must be removed from trunk.

Graduation

Full department uniform and accessories are required for graduation.
