What is happening?

A virtual public information meeting for the Newton Corner Long-Term Planning Study will be held on Tuesday, February 25, 2025, from 6:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Zoom.

At this meeting, the study team will review the future conditions analysis and review the issues, constraints, and opportunities within the study area. The team will also solicit feedback from the public about initial alternative development ideas through breakout sessions. The study will consider long-term means to improve safety, congestion, accessibility, mobility, connectivity, and quality of life in the study area. The product of this work will be a final report that documents the process and includes potential long-term improvements.
