Advisory: Newton, Weston Overnight Closures of I-90 Westbound Ramp to Park Drive

Overnight closure on night of Wednesday January 7, 10:00 pm to 5:00 am the following morning

NEWTON/WESTON– The Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) is announcing upcoming closures of the ramps from I-90 westbound exit 123B to Park Drive in Weston. This ramp will be closed during the overnight hours on Wednesday, January 7, from 10:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. the following morning.

Drivers seeking to access Park Drive from I-90 westbound will be rerouted to exit 123A, utilizing exit 39A to Route 30, then continuing westbound to Park Drive.

This closure is necessary for crews to safely conduct construction operations related to the Newton/Weston bridge rehabilitation project at I-90/I-95 interchange.

Drivers traveling through the affected areas should expect delays, reduce speed, and use caution.

Appropriate signage, law enforcement details, and advanced message boards will be in place to guide drivers through the work area.

All scheduled work is weather dependent and/or may be impacted due to an emergency.
