Overnight Ramp Closures at I-90/I-95 Interchange

*Overnight closures on nights of Tuesday, January 6, Thursday, January 8, Friday January 9,
10:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. the following morning*

NEWTON/WESTON – The Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) is announcing overnight closures of multiple ramps at the I-90/I-95 interchange in Newton and Weston. All closures will take place nightly Tuesday, January 6, and Thursday, January 8, and Friday, January 9, from 10:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. the following morning.

The following ramps will be closed during overnight hours:

- Ramp from I-95 (Route 128) northbound to Route 30 (exit 39A/ Collector Distributor Road).
- Ramps from I-95 (Route 128) northbound (exit 39B) to I-90 eastbound and I-90 westbound.
- Ramps from I-90 eastbound and I-90 westbound to I-95 (Route 128) northbound.

Detours will be in place as follows:

- Drivers seeking to access exit 39A/Route 30 will be redirected to I-95/Route 128 northbound to exit 41 will be directed to take exit 41 to reverse direction to I-95/Route 128 southbound and then follow I-95/Route 128 southbound to exit 39.
- Drivers seeking to access I-90 eastbound and I-90 westbound from I-95/Route 128 northbound exit 39B will be directed to take exit 41 to reverse direction to I-95/Route 128 southbound and then use the ramp at exit 39A.
- Drivers seeking to access I-95/Route 128 northbound from I-90 eastbound and I-90 westbound will be directed to travel on I-95/Route 128 southbound where they may take exit 37 to reverse direction and continue onto I-95/Route 128 northbound.

This closure is necessary for crews to safely conduct construction operations related to the Newton/Weston bridge rehabilitation project.

Appropriate signage and law enforcement details will be in place to guide drivers through the work area.

Drivers traveling through the area should expect delays, reduce speed, and use caution.

All scheduled work is weather dependent and subject to change without notice.
