



## **Project Goals**

Multimodal Design Approach - Balance needs of ALL users

#### To Improve Pedestrian Accommodations

- Continuous designated sidewalks
- Designated crosswalks

#### To Provide Bicycle Accommodations

- 5 foot wide raised bike lane
- Shared use path connections

#### To Improve Traffic Operations/ Safety

- Exclusive turn lanes, two-way left turn lanes
- Protected phasing at signals
- Reduce conflict points

#### To Improve Transit

Adjust locations to optimize service (Newton)











## **Existing Conditions**

- Urban Arterial
- Commercial and Residential Area
- Average Daily Traffic = 28,000 VPD
- Stone Arch Bridge (1875) individually listed on the National Register of Historic Places
- Trail Connections
  - Charles River Reservation, Needham
  - Upper Falls Greenway, Newton
- MBTA Bus Routes 52 & 59
- Overhead Utility Wires on both sides of street

Parking perpendicular to road




- 1.7 miles of Roadway Reconstruction
  - Roadway widening /
  - Full depth construction /
  - Mill & overlay
- Raised bike lane / sidewalk installation
- Shared Use Path for bikes and pedestrians
- Traffic signal replacements 5 locations
- New traffic signal installation 2 locations
- Installation of stormwater basin and infiltration trenches



Bid Opening April 2020 Construction Completed Fall 2023




