Dear Mr. Sidie:

The Board of Registration in Pharmacy (Board) is in receipt of your letter dated December 14, 2009 stating you agree to surrender your Massachusetts Pharmacy Technician Registration No. 9024 (exp. 01/04/2011), effective on mailing date December 14, 2009, in resolution of above-referenced Complaint Docket No. PHA-2009-0200 (the Complaint).

Please be advised that the Board has accepted the surrender of your pharmacy technician registration on the terms and condition that you understand and agree your surrender is voluntarily tendered; that registration surrender is considered to be a disciplinary action depriving you of all privileges of registration; that the surrender is not subject to reconsideration or judicial review; that you are not currently licensed in any other jurisdiction as a pharmacy technician; and that the Board will not review any application for licensure or registration as a pharmacy technician in the future.

If you do not agree to the above described terms and conditions by which the Board has accepted the surrender of your pharmacy intern registration in resolution of the Complaint, **you must notify the Board in writing at the address above within 30 days of the date of this letter.** If the Complaint is not resolved by agreement with the Board, the Board will refer the matter to the Office of Public Protection for the initiation of formal adjudicatory proceedings seeking discipline of your pharmacy technician license.

Please be advised that the Board will close the Complaint as a "voluntarily surrender" on February 15, 2010 if you have not otherwise notified the Board by that date.
