

PUBLIC NOTICE

The Retirement Board members (the “Board”) of the Norfolk County Retirement System (the “System”) are seeking Requests for Proposal from investment management firms to manage part of the System’s defined benefit plan assets in a Small Cap Passive Equity product managed to replicate the risk and return of the Russell 2000 Index. The System’s target allocation to small cap equities is 8.5% and the total assets of the System were approximately \$1.3 billion as of July 31, 2022 according to the Plan’s custodian. While the precise dollar allocation for this assignment will be determined at the time of funding, we expect the allocation to be between \$30 and \$50 million, but the client has the discretion to allocate a lesser or higher amount.
