**DECISION**

**BETLOU CORP. D/B/A CITY SPIRITS NORTH  
255-271 EAST WASHINGTON STREET  
NORTH ATTLEBORO, MA 02760

Betlou Corp. d/b/a City Spirits North (“Licensee” or “City Spirits North”) holds an alcohol license issued pursuant to M.G.L. c. 138, § 15. The Alcoholic Beverages Control Commission (“Commission” or “ABCC”) held a hearing on Tuesday, August 5, 2025, regarding an alleged violation of M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 18 Acting as a wholesaler without being properly licensed. Prior to the commencement of the hearing the Licensee stipulated to the facts alleged in Investigator McDonough’s Report.

The following documents are in evidence:

1. Report of Investigator D. McDonough;
2. ABCC Form 43, Transfer of License Approval, 9/13/2001;
3. Wholesaler Invoices for Alcohol Sold to Betlou Corp. d/b/a City Spirits North;
4. Licensee Stipulation of Facts.

There is one (1) audio recording of this hearing.

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. On Thursday, February 12, 2025, Investigators Keefe, Smiddy and McDonough (“Investigators”) inspected Philmar Corp. d/b/a City Spirits II (“City Spirits II”) which is located at 524 Pleasant Street in Attleboro and holds a M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 15 license. Michael Foster is President, Treasurer, Director, and 50% Shareholder. Lois Foster is Secretary, Director and 50% Shareholder.
2. At approximately 11:30 a.m., Investigators entered the licensed premises, identified themselves to the general manager, Joshua DeFronzo, advised him of a complaint received by the ABCC and that they would be conducting an inspection of the licensed premises.
3. Mr. DeFronzo stated to Investigators that he moves alcoholic beverages between City Spirits and City Spirits II to resupply low inventory.

4. Investigators entered the storage room and observed approximately twenty (20) cases of assorted alcoholic beverages with address labels indicating the alcohol had been delivered by a § 18 wholesaler to Betlou Corp d/b/a City Spirits North.
5. Investigators asked Mr. DeFronzo to provide them with invoices for the twenty (20) cases of alcohol. The invoices provided were from a § 18 licensed wholesaler and addressed to Betlou Corporation, City Spirits North, 255-271 East Washington Street, North Attleboro, Massachusetts.
6. Michael Foster is President, Treasurer, Director, and 50% Shareholder of Betlou Corporation. Lois Foster is Secretary, Director and 50% Shareholder.
7. At approximately 12:45 p.m., Investigators entered the licensed premises of City Spirits North and identified themselves to the manager on duty. Investigators advised him of the complaint received by the ABCC regarding City Spirits II and that they would be conducting an inspection of the licensed premises.
8. Investigators entered the storage room of the licensed premises and observed that all cases of alcohol were addressed to Betlou Corp. d/b/a City Spirits North.
9. Mr. Foster and Mr. DeFronzo appeared at the Commission hearing.
10. The Licensee has held a license under M.G.L. c. 138, § 15 since 2001 with no prior violations.


CONCLUSION

Based on the evidence, the Commission finds the Licensee violated M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 18 Acting as a wholesaler without being properly licensed. Therefore, the Commission **SUSPENDS the license for a period of ten (10) days of which four (4) days will be served and six (6) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations are found by this Commission.**

After a hearing on August 5, 2025, the Commission finds Betlou Corp. d/b/a City Spirits North violated M.G.L. Ch. 138, § 18 Acting as a wholesaler without being properly licensed.

The Commission **SUSPENDS** the license for a period of ten (10) days of which four (4) days will be served and six (6) days will be held in abeyance for a period of two (2) years provided no further violations of Chapter 138 or Commission Regulations are found by this Commission.

**The suspension shall commence on Monday, January 12, 2026, and terminate on Thursday, January 15, 2026.** The license will be delivered to the Local Licensing Board or its designee on Monday, January 12, 2026, at 9:00 A.M. It will be returned to the licensee on January 16, 2026.

You are advised that pursuant to the provisions of M.G.L. c. 138 § 23, you may petition the Commission to accept an offer in compromise in lieu of suspension within twenty (20) calendar days following such notice of such suspension. If accepted, you may pay a fine using the enclosed form which must be signed by the Licensee and a Massachusetts Licensed Accountant.

You are advised that you have the right to appeal this decision under M.G.L. c. 30A to Superior Court within thirty (30) days upon receipt of this notice.
