## **NOTICE OF AGENCY ACTION**

SUBJECT: MassHealth: Amendment to the Standard Alternative Benefit Plan State Plan

(Adult Day Health)

**AGENCY**: Massachusetts Executive Office of Health and Human Services (EOHHS)

EOHHS is implementing a technical correction to the Standard Alternative Benefit Plan (ABP) State Plan to reclassify Adult Day Health services (ADH) as a preventive service rather than a rehabilitative service. The purpose of the amendment is to align the categorization of this service with the Medicaid State Plan, which categorizes ADH as a preventative service. This amendment will not affect how MassHealth provides ADH services.

## **EPSDT** and Tribal Consultation

The amendments will not affect how MassHealth provides Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic and Treatment (EPSDT) services. EOHHS has followed the tribal consultation noticing process established under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 and set forth in its approved state plan.

## **Public Comments**
