# ELECTED MEMBER POSITION Three year term

The position of elected board member is an unpaid position and requires the following:

- Attendance at each monthly meeting and special meetings as necessary,
- Completion and submission of a Statement of Financial Interest to the Public Employee Retirement Administration Commission (PERAC) with the first statement being due within 30 days after election, and
- Attendance at various conferences and/or training sessions to earn PERAC required 18
  educational credits during each three year term. (At least 3 educational credits must be
  earned in each year. A board member will not be credited with more than 9 educational
  credits in any one year.)

Only active members or retired members may run for the position.
