Absentee Ballots:

IF more than one candidate has been nominated an official ballot will be prepared.

- Absentee ballots will be mailed to all retirees by November 1, 2024
- Non-retired members (active or inactive) may request absentee ballots IN WRITING by 3:00 PM on November 29, 2024 if they cannot vote in person at the retirement office by reason of medical condition, religious beliefs, or if they will be absent from Shrewsbury during the election hours.
- All absentee ballots will be counted **ONLY** if they are received **no later than 1 PM** on December 11, 2024

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**ELECTED MEMBER POSITION
Three year term**

The position of elected board member is an unpaid position and requires the following:

- Attendance at each monthly meeting and special meetings as necessary,
- Completion and submission of a Statement of Financial Interest to the Public Employee Retirement Administration Commission (PERAC) with the first statement being due within 30 days after election, and
- Attendance at various conferences and/or training sessions to earn PERAC required 18 educational credits during each three year term. (At least 3 educational credits must be earned in each year. A board member will not be credited with more than 9 educational credits in any one year.)

Only active members or retired members may run for the position.
