It is anticipated that the following will be discussed at the aforementioned meeting:

1. Roll Call
2. Discussion regarding a product variance request to install an automated parking device to be located at 30 Penniman Road, Allston. – Quasi-Judicial Session pursuant to M.G.L. c. 30A, §18 (Closed Session).
3. **71 Charles Street – Boston, MA**  
Requesting a variance for a shallow pit passenger elevator and for a non-standard machine room.
4. **100 Federal Street – Beverly, MA**  
Requesting a variance install an enclosed platform lift that exceeds the maximum allowed travel of 14'-0".
5. Approval of meeting minutes from May 12, 2020.
6. Old business (The Board may or may not discuss):



- Discussion regarding mounting video screens in elevator cabs, specifically three walls of the cab would be a video display.
  - 36 Stoney Brook Road, Hopkinton - The petitioner was in front of the Board on March 3, 2020 seeking a variance from ASME A17.1-2013 Section 5.3.1.10.1 – Private Residence Elevators Capacity. Placed on hold for 30 days.
  - 174 Ipswich Street, Boston – The petitioner was in front of the Board on May 5, 2020 seeking a variance from ASME A18.1-2014 Section 2.1.1.1, to allow a 36” high guard at the upper landing. Placed on hold for 90 days.
  - Discussion regarding 524 CMR 35:00 Section 2.8.3.3 – Sprinklers shall not be permitted in power passenger or freight elevator hoistways, pits, machine rooms or control spaces.
  - Discussion regarding the adoption of the 2016 elevator code.
  - Discussion regarding new Controller/Fire Service.
