VARIANCE REQUEST

PV-189 - Polar Park - Madison Street – Worcester

Applicant Shane Wise of R. W. Sullivan, Inc is requesting a variance from 248 CMR 10.10 (10) and 10.17 (2). The main concourse level of the stadium is covered but open on two sides which will allow rain to enter the area during heavy winds. Based on information provided in the variance application the owner of the property is the City of Worcester. The request is to pipe the floor drains to the storm system and size the drains according to sanitary drainage fixture units. Included with this application was written documentation that the Worcester Board of Health has been petitioned regarding this variance request.
