Description of Changes

The following are proposed changes to rates for personal care attendant (PCA) services effective for dates of service provided on or after July 1, 2024.

The estimated increase in annual aggregate expenditures due to the PCA rates effective July 1, 2024, is \$111.8 million for MassHealth PCA services provided on a fee-for-service basis.

The proposed rates noted above include the PCA wage and the employer expense component, which includes employer required taxes and workers' compensation insurance. The proposed increase in rates follows the terms of the collective bargaining agreement negotiated between the Commonwealth of Massachusetts and the PCA union (1199SEIU) and is in accordance with 101 CMR 309.00: *Rates for Certain Services for the Personal Care Attendant Program*.
