Notice is hereby given that the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (MassDEP), under its authority pursuant to M.G.L. Chapter 111, Sections 142A through 142M, and in conformance with the requirements of 310 CMR 7.38(5), will hold a public meeting on the Renewal Application for the Central Artery/Tunnel Project Operating Certification (Certification) pursuant to Certification of Tunnel Ventilation Systems in the Metropolitan Boston Air Pollution Control District, 310 CMR 7.38. The certification was submitted by the Massachusetts Department of Transportation (MassDOT) on June 14, 2021.
