PUBLIC NOTICE OF A DRAFT HAZARDOUS WASTE FACILITY LICENSE AND OPTIONAL PUBLIC HEARING PURSUANT TO MASSACHUSETTS GENERAL LAW CHAPTER 21C AND MASSACHUSETTS HAZARDOUS WASTE REGULATIONS, 310 CMR 30.000.

PROPOSED:

Triumvirate Environmental (Merrimack), Inc. ("Triumvirate" or "Facility") is an existing hazardous waste storage facility operating under the terms of Massachusetts Hazardous Waste Facility License #34B/2013, issued on March 7, 2013. Triumvirate has applied for a five-year license renewal from the Massachusetts Department of Environmental Protection (the "MassDEP") to continue its operation.

A Draft License has been issued by MassDEP. Pursuant to the public participation requirements cited in 310 CMR 30.800, the public has 45 (forty-five) days to comment on the Draft License.

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Any member of the public wishing to comment on the Draft License may file written comments during the public comment period that will begin on May 31, 2019 and end at 5 p.m. on July 15, 2019. Comments must be submitted to:

Pursuant to 310 CMR 30.837(1), i during the comment period or within 15 days of the close of the comment period MassDEP receives written notice requesting a public hearing or if MassDEP determines on its own that there is significant public interest in the Draft License, MassDEP will schedule an informal public hearing on the proposed action. Written and oral comments will be accepted at the hearing.

The Draft License and a Fact Sheet that describes the licensing process, the company, its operation, and terms and conditions of the Draft License are available for review at the Lowell Public Health Department, the Lowell Public Library, MassDEP's Wilmington and Boston offices, and the USEPA New England – Region I Office in Boston. Anyone wishing to examine the Draft License may do so at these locations. FINAL DECISION:

MassDEP will consider all written comments received during the comment period; all comments received at a hearing, if held; and the requirements of the Massachusetts Hazardous Waste Regulations, 310 CMR 30.000, pertaining to licensing. MassDEP will then make a final decision regarding the issuance of a hazardous waste license to Triumvirate Environmental (Merrimack), Inc. A notice of the final license decision will be sent to the applicant and to each person who has submitted written comments, or has otherwise requested notice of the final license decision. If no comments requesting a change in the Draft License are received, a final decision will become effective 21 days after the date of the notice of the decision. The final license decision will be postponed if a request for an adjudicatory hearing before MassDEP is made within the 21 day period.
